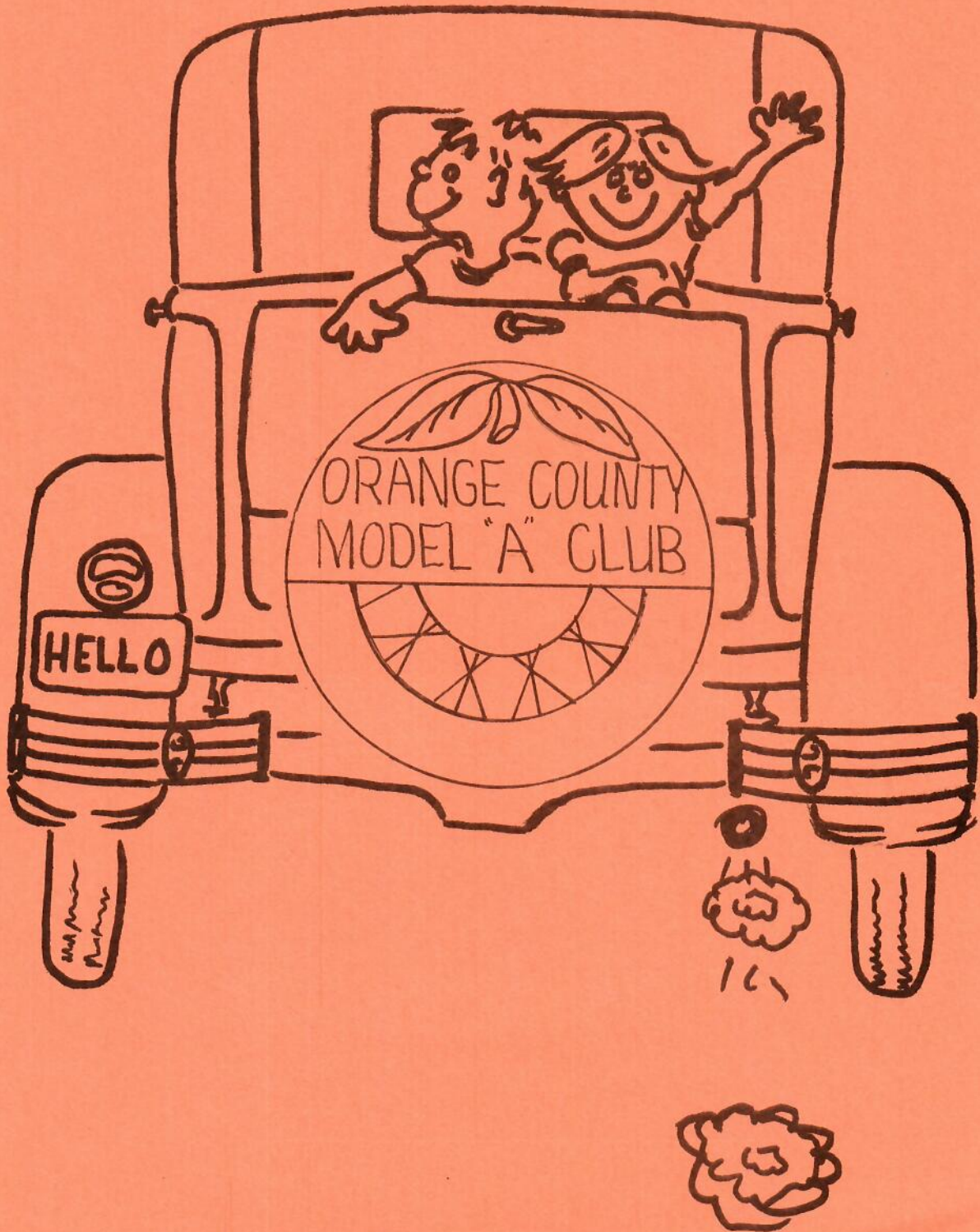

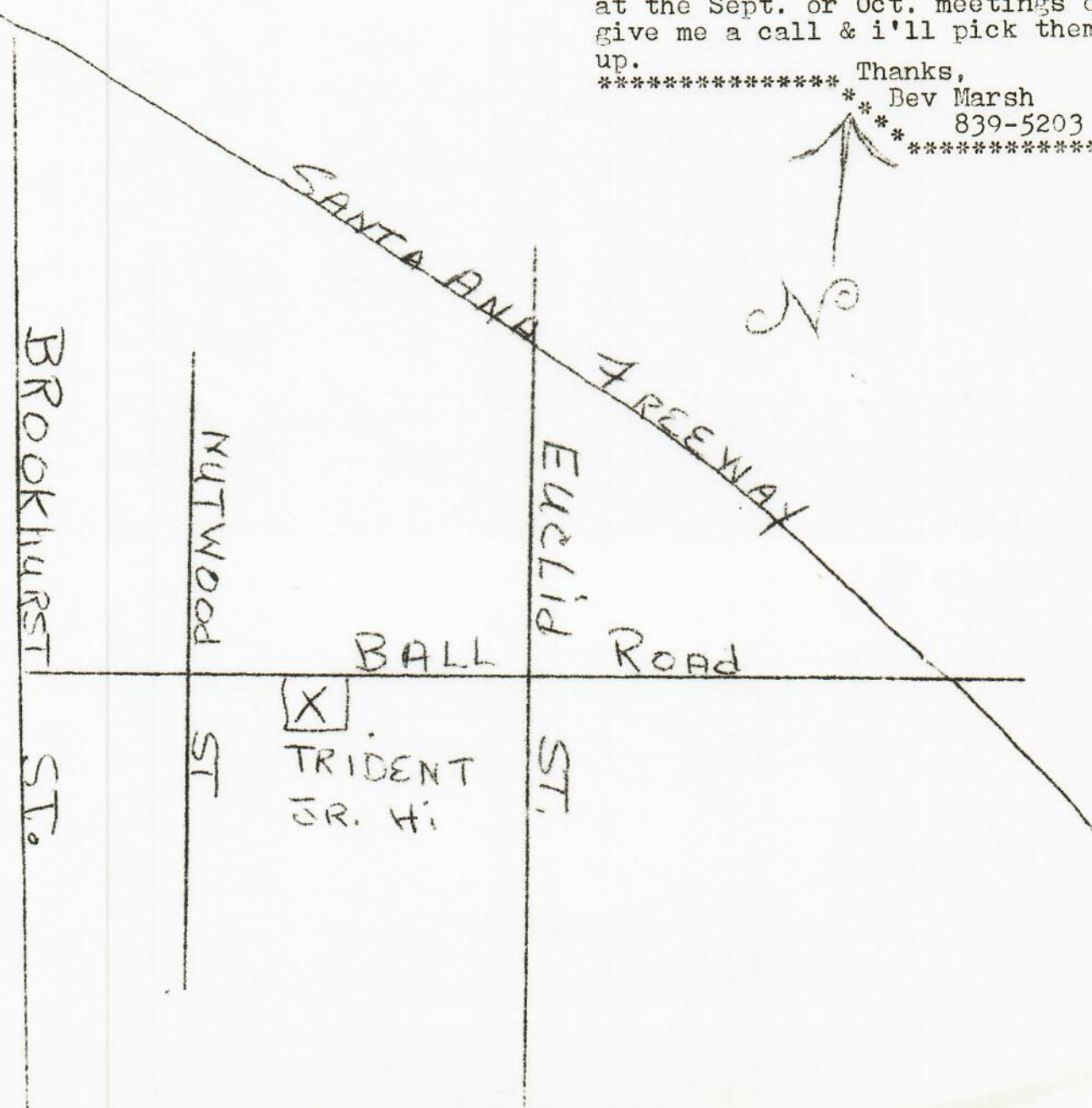
MAP TO TRIDENT JR. HIGH SCH.
